CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Dust and wipe regularly** using a soft microfiber, dry cloth to remove dirt and surface oils.
- **Clean gently** with a light damp cloth. Always test in an inconspicuous area first.
- **Blot spills immediately**, do not rub. Use a clean, dry microfiber cloth to absorb moisture and prevent staining.
- **Avoid harsh cleaners**, alcohol-based products, or household detergents, as they can dry out or discolor the leather.
- **Condition occasionally** using a leather conditioner designed for top-grain leather to keep it supple and prevent cracking.
- **Keep away from direct sunlight** and heat sources, which can cause fading, drying, or warping over time.
- **Avoid sharp objects**, buckles, or pet claws that may scratch or puncture the leather surface.
- **Do not saturate with water**; top-grain leather is not waterproof and can be damaged by excessive moisture.
- **Maintain a stable environment**; extreme humidity or dryness can affect the leather's texture and integrity.
