Oak veneer combines the timeless beauty of natural oak with the stability and consistency of a crafted surface. Its refined grain and warm finish bring elegance to any space while allowing for lighter, more sustainable construction. With regular care, oak veneer furniture will maintain its appearance and integrity for years to come.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Dust frequently** using a soft, dry microfiber cloth to prevent buildup and preserve the wood's finish.
- **Clean gently** with a damp cloth. Wipe in the direction of the grain, then dry immediately with a clean cloth.
- **Avoid soaking** or allowing moisture to sit; excess water can seep into the veneer and cause warping or bubbling.
- **Do not use** abrasive pads, bleach, or harsh chemical cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Use coasters**, placemats, and felt pads under items to protect against scratches, heat marks, and water rings.
- **Keep away** from direct sunlight and heat sources, as prolonged exposure can cause fading or cracking.
- **Avoid** placing heavy or sharp objects directly on the surface to prevent dents or gouging.
- **Do not drag** items across the surface; lift and place gently to avoid scratching the veneer.
