With mindful care, reclaimed oak furniture will continue to age gracefully and add warmth to your home for generations.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Dust regularly** uses a soft, dry microfiber cloth to remove surface dust and maintain the wood's natural finish.
- **Clean gently** with a damp (not wet) cloth. Wipe in the direction of the grain, then dry immediately with a soft cloth.
- **Avoid harsh chemicals**, all-purpose cleaners, or abrasive pads that can strip the finish or damage the wood's surface.
- **Always use coasters**, placemats, and felt pads to protect against water rings, heat marks, and scratches.
- **Wipe spills promptly**, do not let liquids sit as reclaimed wood is porous and can absorb moisture quickly.
- **Keep away from direct sunlight** and heat sources to prevent drying, cracking, or warping over time.
- **Expect natural variations**, knots, and minor movement in the wood—these are part of reclaimed oak's authentic charm.
- **Do not use** wax-based or silicone-based polishes, which can build up and dull the finish.
