CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Clean regularly** using a soft microfiber, damp cloth to remove dust and debris. For deeper cleaning, use clean water. Avoid abrasive scrubbers that may damage the intricate surfaces.
- **Blot spills immediately** with a dry, soft microfiber cloth to prevent stains and water damage, especially around natural crevices and voids.
- **Outdoor exposure will weather the wood**, over time, teak root may develop a silver-gray patina. This is a natural aging process and does not impact structural integrity.
- **Avoid harsh chemicals**, including bleach, ammonia-based products, and furniture polish, as they can affect the finish and texture.
- **Use protective pads** under the base for indoor use to protect flooring. For outdoor use, avoid prolonged contact with wet or damp surfaces.
- **Cover when not in use outdoors**, using breathable covers to minimize dirt buildup, moisture, and UV exposure.
- **Store during severe weather**, shelter or bring indoors during heavy rain or snow to preserve the finish and prevent cracking.
- **Expect natural variations**, teak root can shift slightly with temperature and humidity changes. Minor cracks or separations are normal and part of its rustic charm.
