BEHIND THE DESIGN

Formed over millennia, Travertine brings the raw beauty of nature into the home. With its sun-washed tones and textured surface, it exudes quiet luxury and timeless strength. As a furniture piece, it feels both ancient and modern, a sculptural statement carved from the earth itself.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Use coasters and placemats** to protect the surface from spills, heat, and scratches.
- **Wipe up spills immediately** especially acidic liquids like wine, coffee, or citrus to prevent staining or etching.
- **Clean with a soft, damp cloth** and a pH-neutral cleaner; avoid harsh or abrasive cleaners.
- **Dust regularly** with a dry microfiber cloth to prevent buildup.
- **Seal the surface periodically (every 6–12 months)** to help repel stains and moisture.
- **Avoid placing heavy or sharp objects** directly on the surface to prevent chips or cracks.
- **Do not use acidic or vinegar-based products**, as they can damage the stone's finish.
- **Use felt pads or soft bottoms** under decorative items to avoid scratching the surface.
